

Don't Punish Pain Rally National Organization (DPP National)

State Organizers

Responsibilities:

- Adhere to the Principles, Strategies and Goals established by the National Don't Punish Pain Organization, hereafter referred to as "DPP National".
- Define tactics for implementing the Principles, Strategies and Goals of DPP National at the State level.
- Coordinate all Rally activities within the State.
- Develop strategies, language and discussion points for all news media within your State.
- Manage all communications with news media within your State.
- Be willing and able to speak with news media within your State.
- Be available on Facebook in your State group throughout each day to:
 - review and approve member requests,
 - share all DPP National communications,
 - share and communicate reports, articles and news stories to help educate members as to the latest information available regarding chronic pain patients.
- Devise strategies to recruit new members to the State group. Implement those strategies.
- Organize all details for each Rally within your State.
 - Define venue.
 - Obtain permit when necessary.
 - Communicate Rally date and schedule to State group members.
 - Ensure Rally signs are made.
 - Obtain all pertinent materials from the DPP National website.
 - Provide copies of Rally fliers, pamphlets and other key documents for handout at your State Rally.
 - Notify news media of upcoming Rallies at pre-defined intervals leading up to the Rally to ensure the State Rally is on their coverage schedule for that day, as well as a press release just prior to Rally.
 - Continue to communicate Rally date and time to State group members and promote attendance.
 - Prior to Rally, provide communication to all State group members regarding Rally time, meeting point and member responsibilities.
 - Arrive at Rally venue early and ensure all setup activities are completed.
 - Arrange and provide schedule for those speaking at the Rally.
 - During the Rally, obtain a headcount and record name of each news media in attendance.
 - Monitor behavior at Rally and manage appropriately.
 - Plan and provide for Facebook "Live" recording of the Rally.
 - At close of Rally, ensure the area is clean and all is as it was when you arrived.
 - Once home, provide Rally wrap-up to DPP National.
